Biography

Chris Jericho, a talented actor, television personality, radio host and rock star, has established himself as a multifaceted performer. Jericho made the crossover to film with his first lead role in the Sci-Fi Channel's 2005 original film "2Human." He has a supporting role in New Line Cinema's action thriller "Shoot 'Em Up," which stars Clive Owen and is due out in 2007.

A regular on VH1's "Best Week Ever" and on E! Entertainment Television, Chris has appeared as a commentator on more than a dozen shows including "101 Biggest Celebrity Oops" on E! and the VH1 series "Heavy: The Story of Metal," "I Love the '70s," "I Love the '80s" and "I Love the '90s." Chris' other guest appearances include "Jimmy Kimmel Live," "The Howard Stern Show," "The Late Late Show" and "Steve Harvey's Big Time." Chris also guest-hosted "The Best Damn Sports Show Period," "MadTV" and MTV2's "Headbanger's Ball."

He began wrestling at age 19, and is best known as one of the most popular wrestling champions in history. In 2001, Chris became the first ever Undisputed Champion of the WWE and is the only performer to have held six different titles in the history of World Wrestling Entertainment.

Chris hosts his own show on XM Satellite Radio entitled "The Rock of Jericho," airing Sunday nights on Da Boneyard (Channel 41). The show allows Chris to display his wide and unique knowledge regarding the world of music.

Chris' knowledge of music spans beyond just facts, as displayed by his role as lead singer of the rock band Fozzy. Their third CD, "All That Remains," was released in 2005, via Chris' own record label Ash Records. Fozzy's first two records sold over 100,000 units and the band played sold-out shows in the United States, Canada, Europe and the United Kingdom.

His talent extends beyond the camera as he also wrote and directed a short comedy film about the band entitled, "Unleashed, Uncensored, Unknown." In addition, Chris directed music videos for Fozzy's tracks "Eat The Rich," "With The Fire" and "Enemy," all of which enjoyed rotation on MTV, MTV2, Fuse and MuchMusic.

Chris grew up in Winnipeg, Canada, and currently resides in Los Angeles and Tampa.
